## The Eastern Caribbean Greenpreneurs Incubator Program Announces Selection of its Third Cohort of Green Entrepreneurs.

The Antigua and Barbuda Investment Authority is pleased to announce that four Antiguan *Greenpreneurs* have been selected as part of the 3<sup>rd</sup> cohort of the Eastern Caribbean *Greenpreneurs* Incubator Program.

The Eastern Caribbean *Greenpreneurs* Incubator Program was launched in 2021 and is a collaborative initiative of the Global Green Growth Institute and the Organization of Eastern Caribbean States which is funded by the Qatar Fund for Development (QFFD).

The programme features twelve weeks of virtual business training to include mentorship, 1-on-1 coaching and networking opportunities culminating in a Business Plan Competition.

Up to 10 businesses can qualify for grants of US \$10,000.
