



## Introduction

This publication provides an overview of the operational performance of the ABSSB sharing details on Registration activity and the processing of both short- and long-term benefits during the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter of 2014 and 2015.

## Registration Activity

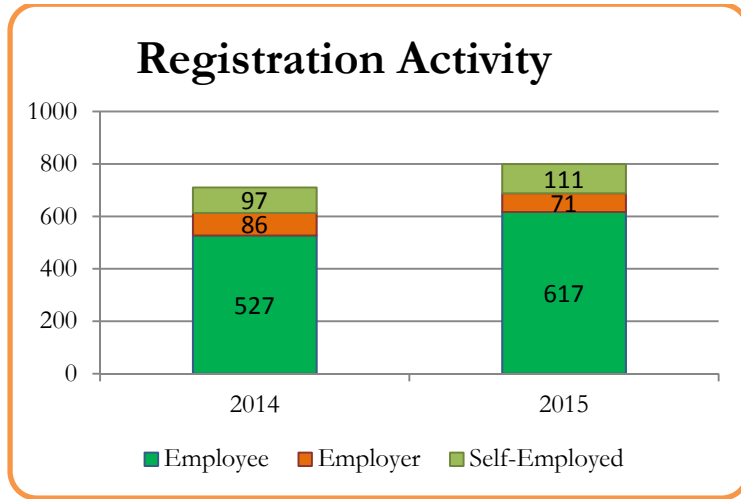


Figure 1 shows a breakdown of registration activity for the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter of 2014 and 2015 respectively. Self Employed registrants totaled **111**, in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter of 2015, indicating an increase of **14.4%** relative to the corresponding period in 2014.

Tables 1 and 2, displays the number of new registrants with the ABSSB by nationality. An increase of **17.1%** in total registration in 2015 is noted, relative to 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter, 2014.

## Benefits Activity

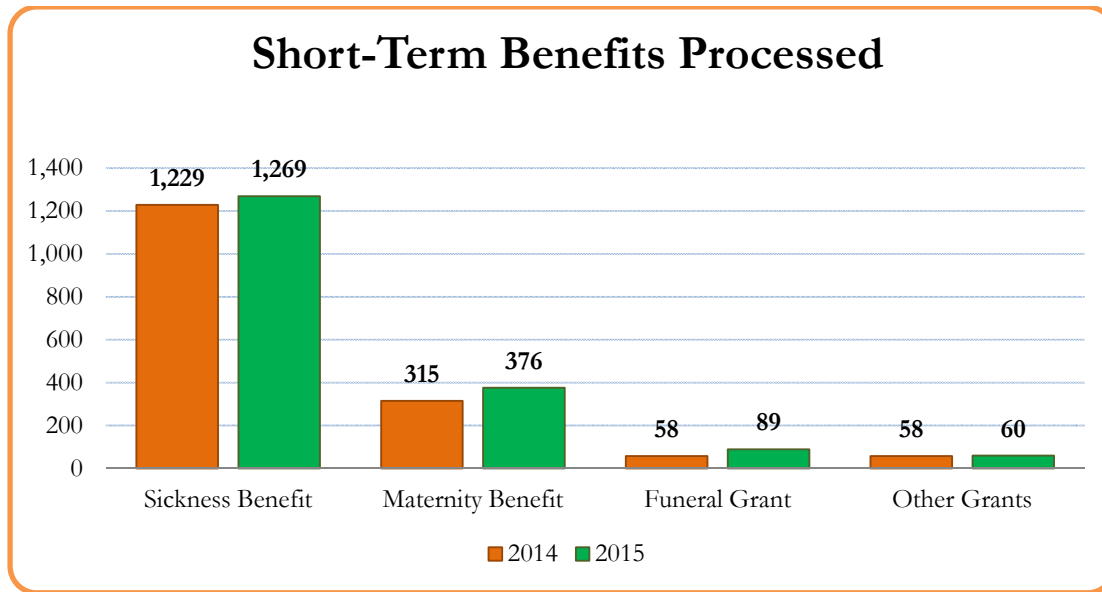

Figure 2 indicates the type of short - term benefits processed by the ABSSB. **Sickness** benefit accounted for **74%** of the short – term claims that were allowed (paid) during the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter, 2014 compared to **71%** in 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter, 2015.

**Pension Profile**

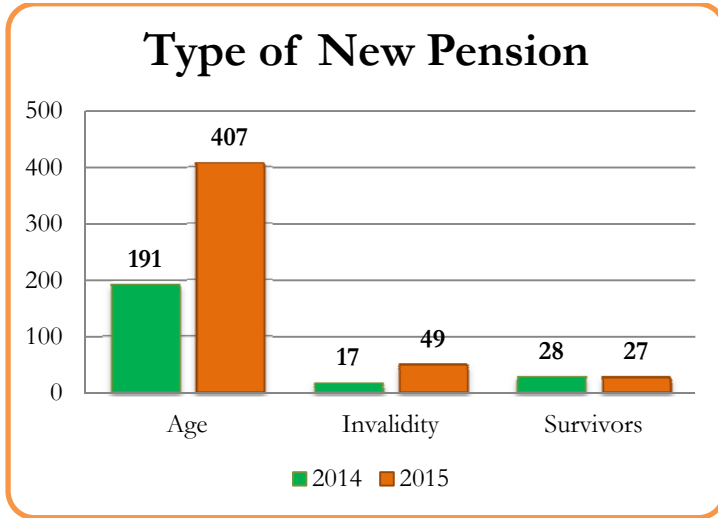


Figure 3 shares the types of new pensions that were processed. A total of **191** former contributors qualified for an Age pension in 2014. In 2015, however, there was a significant increase of **113.1%** of Age pension applications.

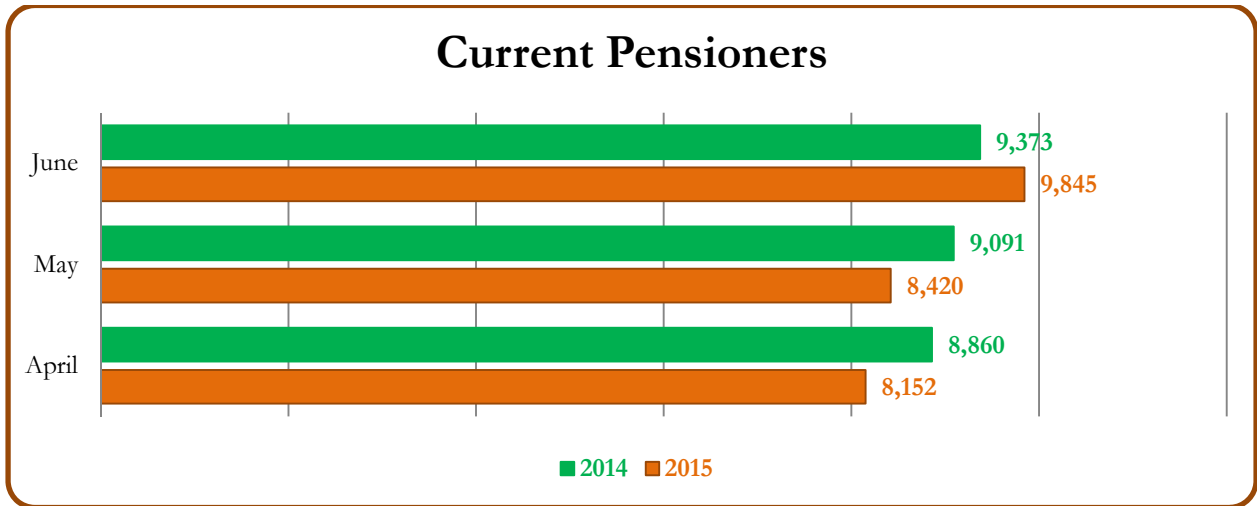
