

NEW Information VISITOR POLICY



There is no greater priority than the health and safety of our patients, team members and the communities we serve. COVID-19 is a novel virus that poses an unprecedented threat to our patients, especially those who are elderly, have underlying medical conditions or have compromised immune systems. As coronavirus concerns escalate quickly, we have expanded standardized visitor restrictions at Mount St. John's Medical Centre.

No hospital visitors except for parents (*Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) and Pediatric patients*) will be allowed until further notice.

For these exceptions, ONLY one (1) parent/guardian at a time will be allowed to visit/room-in with their child.
