




Selected Vital Stats For 2006 - 2007



**A GLANCE AT STATISTICS**

A Glance at Statistics highlights general information on Antigua and Barbuda; and gives a brief synopsis of Social and Economic indicators for the period 2006–2007. This publication was produced by the Information Systems Section of the Statistics Division, Ministry of Finance & the Economy.

GENERAL INFORMATION - ANTIGUA & BARBUDA

Antigua & Barbuda, a twin nation state in the North Eastern Caribbean has co-ordinates of 17.1°N : 61.5 °W and 17.4 °N: 61.9°W respectively. Together they have a total land mass of 440.3 sq. km or 170 sq. miles. As of 2007, the estimated population stands at 85,903.

Boggy Peak (Proposed: *Mount Obama*), the highest point in Antigua, stands at a height of 405.5 metres or 1330 feet. The official language is English. The Eastern Caribbean dollar (EC) is the official currency used, with an exchange rate of approximately ECS2.70 = US\$1.00.

There are many scenic and historical sites in Antigua and Barbuda. These include Shirley's Heights, Nelson Dockyard, Fig Tree Drive, Devil's Bridge, Betty's Hope Plantation, and the St. John Anglican Cathedral; and in Barbuda the Caves and the Bird Sanctuary.
